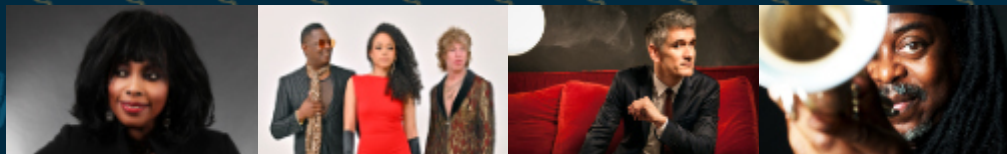
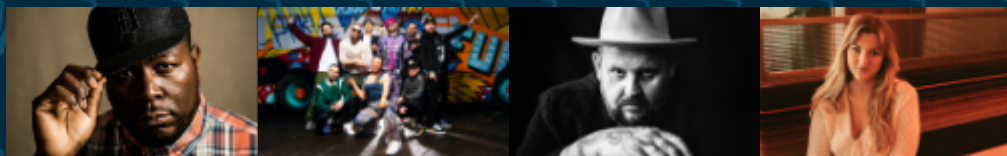

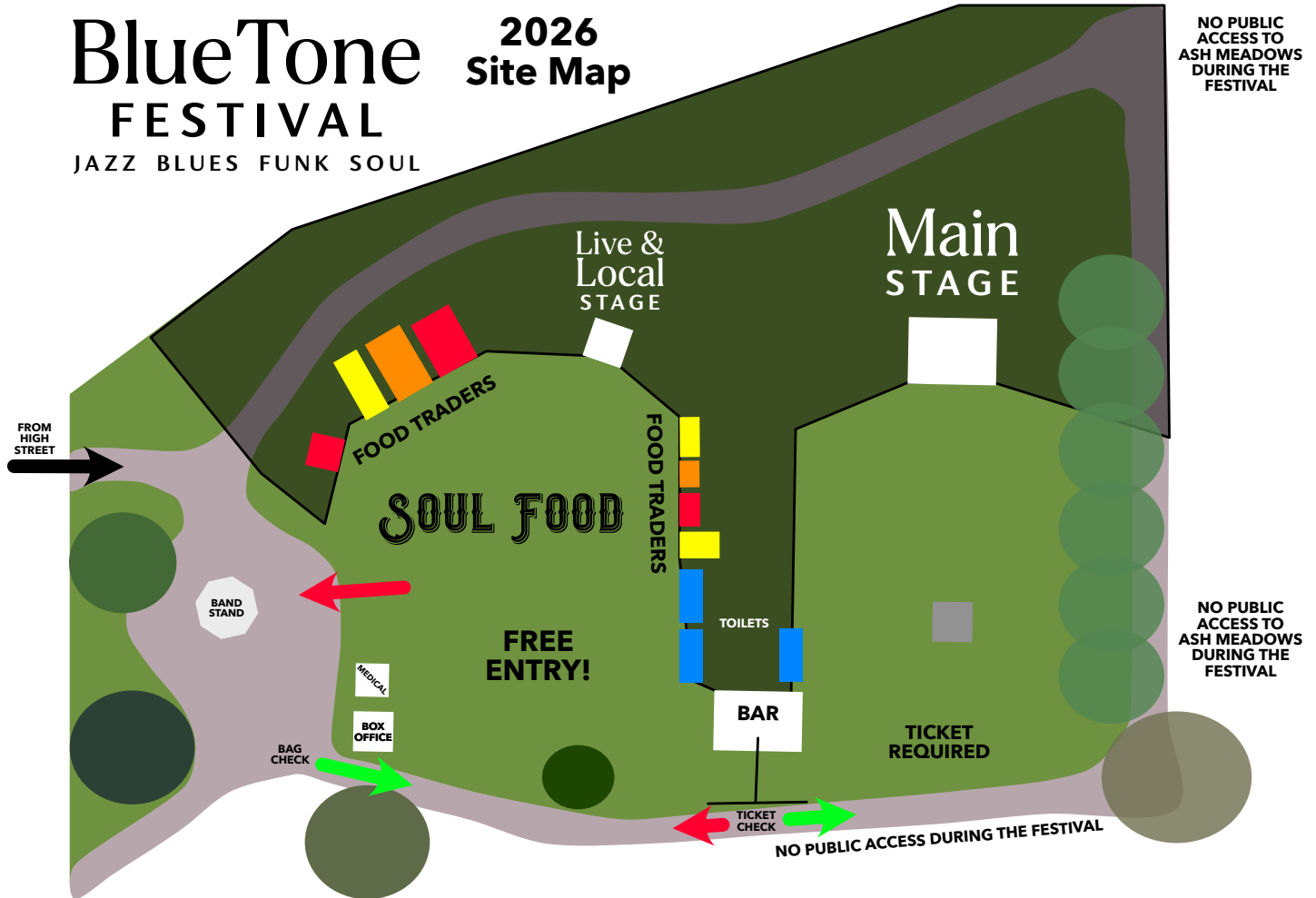

About the festival

BlueTone Festival arrives in the heart of Taunton from 28th-31st May 2026, bringing four days of jazz, blues, funk and soul to Vivary Park and venues across the town. Created with a long-term vision to grow into one of the South West's most exciting cultural events, BlueTone combines internationally recognised artists with emerging talent, local performers, great food and drink, and a welcoming festival atmosphere right in the centre of Somerset.

Across the weekend, festival goers can experience headline performances from artists including Ruby Turner, The Brand New Heavies, Curtis Stigers and Courtney Pine, alongside dozens of other acts performing across the festival. From big evening concerts in the main arena to the free-to-access Soul Food & Live & Local Stage celebrating grassroots and up-and-coming artists, BlueTone is designed to capture the spirit of discovery, community and live music at its best.

Visitors will also be able to enjoy street food, artisan traders, relaxed daytime performances, award-winning bars from Branscombe Brewery, and a vibrant festival setting designed to encourage people to spend time in the town across the entire weekend. BlueTone aims to create the feel of a destination festival while remaining accessible and welcoming to the local community - blending the atmosphere of major UK music festivals with the character and charm of Taunton itself.

BlueTone is presented by Taunton Collaborative Arts CIC, a Community Interest Company created to support creativity, opportunity and cultural development in Taunton and Somerset. Profits generated by the festival are intended to be reinvested back into the event and the wider creative arts community - helping support local artists, education projects, live performance opportunities and future cultural events.

Whether you're here for world-class music, incredible food and drink, discovering new artists, or simply soaking up the atmosphere in beautiful Vivary Park, we hope BlueTone 2026 is the beginning of something special for Taunton.

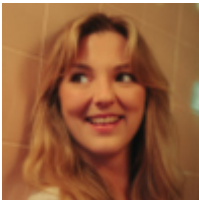
